

RULES AND REGULATIONS OF PARTICIPATION IN THE ACADEMY OF THE FINEST ARTS AT
WOODSTOCK FESTIVAL POLAND 2017

Held by the Great Orchestra of Christmas Charity Foundation in Kosztyn nad Odrą on 02-05.08.2017

1. Non-governmental organizations (such as associations, foundations, religious associations) companies and private individuals (hereinafter known as 'Organization') can take part in Woodstock Festival Poland 2017 (hereinafter known as 'Woodstock Poland') having obtained the Great Orchestra of Christmas Charity Foundation's (hereinafter known as the 'Foundation') permission. The Foundation approves of all materials and stall programme presented by the Organization beforehand. Woodstock Poland is the festival created by the Foundation as a space for exchange of ideas and opinions which do not breach legal status.
2. Organization which has accepted the invitation to present its activities and programme within the framework of Academy of the Finest Arts is obliged to provide the Foundation with a detailed outline of their activity and after the end of the festival, it is obliged to present an account of its activity at the event and to attach pictures to it. By sending these images the Organization confirms that they have obtained the permission to use images and that it grants the Foundation with permission to use the images.
3. The deadline for submissions falls on 30th of April 2017. The Foundation reserves the right to extend the deadline.
4. The organization participating in Woodstock Poland covers all the costs of its participation in the event. It means that the Organization which holds a stall at Woodstock Poland has to cover all the costs incurred by its participation in the event.
5. The Organization cannot cede its space to another organization or invite another organization to co-run the stall without obtaining a permission from the Foundation to do so.
6. The Organization is obliged to make sure that all health and safety regulations are met at the area of their stall (health and safety, fire regulations, sanitation regulations).
7. The Organization's stall should be clearly marked, and the design should fit the colour scheme of the Festival as well as aesthetically complete the overall look of the area.
8. The Organization is obliged to provide logos of partners and sponsors for the Foundation's approval.
9. The stall shall be open to the public from August the 3rd until August the 5th between the hours of 10 am and 8 pm. In some cases the opening hours can be adjusted accordingly.
10. The Organization is obliged to provide a detailed plan of their activities by May 31st 2017, which is then approved by the Foundation.
11. All changes to the plan of the activities should be agreed upon with the Foundation.
12. The Organization cannot raise funds as a part of their activity at the stall.
13. The Organization cannot run any business activity from their stall (it includes the sale of t-shirts, promotional materials, and any services provided by the Organization)
14. The Foundation forbids the sale and distribution of any foodstuffs, beverages, stimulants and controlled substances, alcohol, detergents (glues in particular), pyrotechnic materials, gas canisters, items deemed dangerous (which can be used as weapons in an altercation), tobacco and dope paraphernalia, and gadgets marked by the logo of the current edition of Woodstock Poland.
15. The Organization active as the Academy of the Finest Arts is forbidden from the sale, distribution and use of all and any devices which emit sounds that might hinder the concerts

and recording of them (these items include, but are not limited to: vuvuzelas, trumpets, horns, buzzers,)

16. Organization of any concerts is forbidden in the area of the Academy of the Finest Arts.
17. If any of the items mentioned in points 12-14 are retrieved at the stall, they will be confiscated and the stall shall be closed.
18. The staff running the stall is forbidden from the sale and distribution of alcohol and controlled substances.
19. The Organization is obliged to follow all instructions of Woodstock Poland security service and personnel.
20. The Organization is obliged to clear the area of its stall after the end of their activity.
21. The Organization is obliged to claim the area for their activity by July the 1st.
22. If the Organization violates the provisions of these Rules and Regulations (or Rules and Regulations applicable to the participants of the festival) it will be barred from taking part in Woodstock Poland and asked to leave the area. The Organization cannot appeal from this decision.
23. If an Organization is not invited to participate in Woodstock Poland, but still attempts to operate at Woodstock Poland, might be treated as disruptive of the order of the event.
24. Submitting the application to take part in Woodstock Poland is tantamount to accepting the Rules and Regulations herein.
